What You Need to Know About the 2010 Census

Reasons Why You Want to Fill Out Your 2010 Census Survey;

- **Creates hundreds of thousands of temporary jobs across the nation**
- **\$300 Billion in federal funds awarded to states and communities every year based on census data**
- **Census data guides local decision makers in local community planning (new roads, hospitals, schools, etc)**
- **Census data determines number of Congressional seats each state will have in the U. S. House of Representatives**
- **Census data determines legislative district boundaries**
- **Local businesses use census data to locate supermarkets, shopping centers, new housing, child care & senior citizen centers and other facilities**
- **Census data determines state and local funding and services**
- **Local communities use the census data to gauge financial health and future vital social service programs**
- **Government officials use census data to allocate funding and grants to high-need areas and non-profit organizations**
- **Faith based organizations utilize census data as a source of key statistical information needed to determine for new facilities and to secure faith-based grants**

The 2010 Census only asks: Name, relationship, gender, date of birth, race & whether respondent owns or rents his or her home.

The Census Bureau does not release or share information from individual respondents or their household for 72 years

By law the Census Bureau can not share an individual's answers with anyone, including welfare and immigration
