

**Resolution 04-05-10-03**  
**A Resolution to Authorize Reducing Number of Election Officials for**  
**the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake Polling Place**

**Whereas**, the Village Board has the authority pursuant to Chapter 7.32 of the Wisconsin State Statutes, which allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from 7 to no less than 3; and

**Whereas**, the Village Board has determined that it would be advantageous to the Village to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.

**Now Therefore, Be it Resolved** by the Village Board of the Village of Fontana on Geneva Lake, Walworth County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the Village Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

There shall be a minimum of 3 election officials on duty at every election. At the discretion of the village clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election; however, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number.
